

for sale by regional artists and craftspeople, while the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor gallery held a special exhibition by prominent artists who resided on the Eastern Shore. Art donations from these artists launched CCART's **Permanent Collection**, which grew to more than 40 art works. At our 20<sup>th</sup> year celebration, CCART auctioned most of these works to provide for our current scholarships. Along with a major exhibition honoring Artist Kip Incheck, who was a supporter and portfolio review judge for CCART, we were able to award the largest scholarships in the past 3 years. To date nearly \$200,000 has supported our talented art students on the Eastern Shore. With your help, the seeds planted years ago by an award to one high school student grew into 25 years of support for nearly 200 students who love art and bring their gifts to us, elevating the importance of the visual arts in our lives.

**And so it has come full circle and we are going home.**

So, my friends, **TOGETHER** we have stayed the course with conviction, CCART has served the talented young artists on the Eastern Shore. From the Cleary Studios in 2000 to our 2020 living room Zoom interviews, we are proud to have found ways to adapt to each new reality. Through this process CCART has become, in a sense, its own work of art.

As CCART enters its 25<sup>th</sup> year, we are excited to return where we began in 1980. In 2025, The Salisbury University Art Department will embrace our mission and continue scholarships to students choosing a Visual Arts college career at Salisbury University.

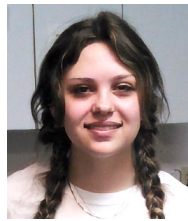

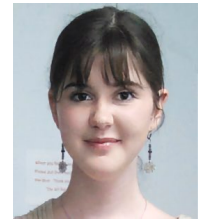
